Entrance Criteria

Applicants for services must have a funding source, such as Far Northern Regional Center, other appropriate agency, and/or private funding.

Applicants will not be denied access to services or discriminated against on the basis of age, sex, sexual orientation, ethnicity, religion, marital status, political interests, disability, or in any other manner as prescribed by state or federal law.
