LRC

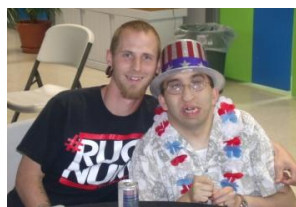

PFS had a calm month in July. Paul D. won the gift card, he was very grateful and gave Kathy a big hug.



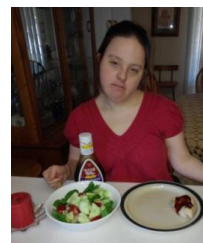
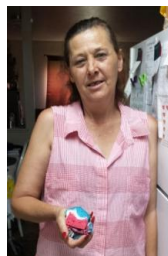
Employee of the Month
